# LETTER FROM THE CHAIR

#### **Dear Taxpayers:**

The Independent Citizens' Oversight Committee (ICOC) is pleased to submit to you the 7th and final Annual Report on the Santee School District's Proposition R Bond Funds. This past year, the District was able to complete the Pepper Drive 10-Classroom Addition project as part of its Capital Improvement Program (CIP). Drive School.

Property values have improved, but it is still uncertain if the remaining \$15 million in G.O. Bonds will be able to be issued to help complete any future projects. The Santee School District Board of Education continues to pursue other means of funding and remains committed to Santee School District facilities..

#### **Committee Findings**

The 7th year Performance and Financial Audits for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, were conducted by Vavrinek, Trine, Day & Co., LLP Certified Public Accountants. Results from the auditors concluded that the District expended General Obligation Bonds, Election 2006 funds only for the specific projects approved by the voters, in accordance with Proposition 39 and outlined in Article XIIIA, Section 1(b)(3)(C) of the California Constitution. It concluded that in all significant respects, the Santee School District has properly accounted for the expenditures held in the Building Fund (G.O. Bonds, Election 2006) and that such expenditures were made for authorized bond projects. 
